## Camp Wild Life Expectations Contract

Hey campers! We are so excited for all the Camp Wild Life adventures we're going to have. Our goal is to promote leadership, responsibility, respectfulness, as well as learn about the amazing environment of Utah and – of course – have fun! To do this, we need your help. We expect you to follow the rules and expectations of camp so that we can all have fun and be safe. Read the contract before signing it, then get a parent to sign before turning this in.

We expect you to be respectful. Respect is treating others the way you'd like to be treated. Examples of being disrespectful include not listening to Camp Wild Life teachers or staff, refusing to participate in planned activities, running away from teachers or staff, or bullying/being disrespectful to fellow campers. Bullying is any verbal or physical action that harms or intimidates another person, such as making fun of someone else's differences, making someone feel bad, or encouraging others to bully someone. Disrespect and bullying is never okay.

Bullying or disrespect can sometimes lead to violence. Camp Wild Life has a zero-tolerance policy for violence. Violence is defined as any physical action that puts the safety of fellow campers, teachers, and staff at risk. Violence includes hitting, biting, pushing, and fighting. All campers, teachers, and staff have the right to feel safe at all times when at Camp Wild Life. Camp Wild Life has a "Three Strikes and You're Out" policy. If you don't adhere to the rules and expectations, you'll first receive a verbal warning. If it happens again, you'll receive a written warning. After that, failure to adhere to the expectations can result in your removal from Camp Wild Life. However, any sort of violence will result in the IMMEDIATE removal from Camp Wild Life.
